<p>Result:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The skin compatibility was evaluated by 95% of the patients as "good" or "very good". • The severity of the symptoms was markedly reduced: erythema (85%), scaling (82%), roughness (80%), dryness (78%), rhagades/erosion (76%), pruritus (74%).

Conclusion: Eucerin® Lipid Shower Oil with 2% polidocanol is very suitable to the cleansing of dry to very dry skin. It is also very well tolerated by patients with sensitive and damaged skin.
